EOS: Intro to Web Hosting

After going through EOS: Intro to Web Hosting tutorial, a few important points I got from the lessons were that the Internet is decentralized by design, and that each internet computer called a host are independent. The operators of the host choose which Internet services to use and which local services to make available to the global Internet community. Web hosting is a service that allows users to post web pages to internet, examples providers include Host Gator and Go Daddy. There were five types of web hosting discussed including shared (share cost of hosting website on the same server), managed (provider is responsible for data and devices), dedicated (pre-configured, dedicated equipment and connectivity from the provider), colocation (customer has complete control over hosting servers in-house), and cloud hosting (provided in virtual environment).
